

## **Ken Cotter 'Anatomy Of A Goddess'**

Ken Cotter is an Irish Singer Songwriter noted for creating sublime new-folk melodies with strong lyrical storylines, driven by a pulsing indie heartbeat. 'Anatomy Of A Goddess' is Ken's third studio album following 'Blue Letter Day' (1998), and 'Agent Orange' (2005). Inspired by James Joyce's Ulysses, 'Anatomy Of A Goddess' is an album full of songs, stories and music. It is a glittering, modern-day contemporary odyssey that echoes the traditional accent and rhythm of the great Irish songwriting tradition.

'Anatomy Of A Goddess,' was recorded throughout 2013 in Dublin's celebrated Cauldron Studios. The album fizzes with outstanding musicianship and beautifully crafted sonic narratives. It features some of Ireland's premier musicians including Bill Shanley, Robbie Malone, Steve Hogan, Gavin Murphy and many more, who between them have worked with many of the legends of Irish and international music.

Musically, the tone of the album sits well alongside Irish singer songwriting legends, Paul Brady and Jimmy MacCarthy, while fans of international songwriters like Rufus Wainwright, Antony Hegarty (Antony & The Johnsons) and Nick Cave will feel at home in it's melodies and production style.
